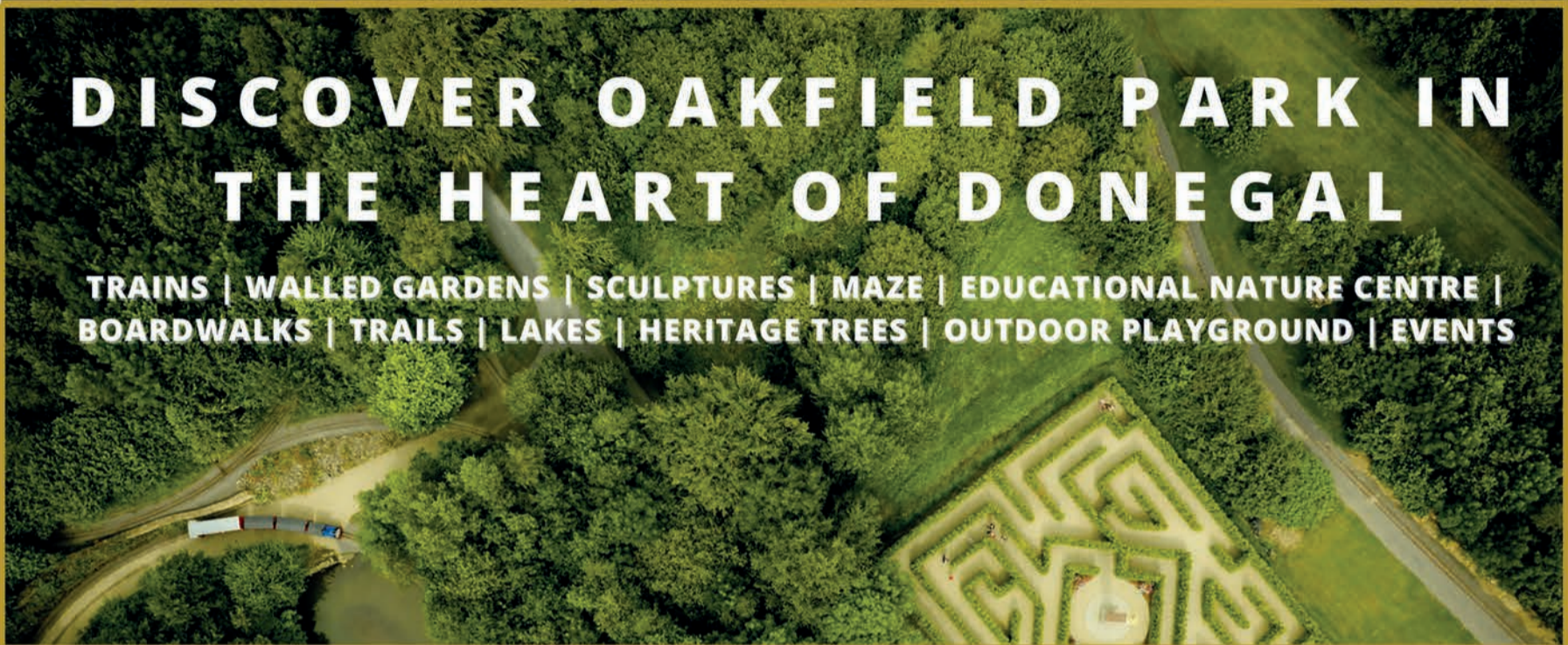

THERE was a large attendance for the opening exhibition of a new series at Garvagh Museum,

one of the North Coast's hidden gems.

They enjoyed music from Glenkeen and

Grove bands, tasty treats provided free by local facility The Pantry, and viewing an impressive exhibition celebrating the Queen's Platinum

Jubilee.

The exhibition continues throughout the season with many new exhibits added to the collection depicting rural life in Ireland.

The collection, started by George McIlroy, a teacher in Garvagh Intermediate School, has grown in size to over 3000 exhibits which have attracted attention from many including Joe Mahon for Mahon's Way.

The exhibits attract the attention of students of history, school children and older folk who enjoy reminiscing when they see items they were familiar with years ago.

The museum is run entirely by volunteers enabling succeeding generations to get a glimpse into the past – part of their heritage.

Right road - Causeway coastal route Best Summer Road Trip

THE Causeway Coastal Route from Belfast to the Giant's Causeway has been named the Best Summer UK Road Trip for 2022.

Northern Ireland's picturesque coastline topped the list of 25 locations curated by global car comparison site EnjoyTravel.com and international travel brand Big 7 Travel.

Also representing Ulster in top trips is the Lough Neagh Loop - a mostly level 113 mile circuit of the largest freshwater lake in Britain and Ireland - which takes in Antrim, Portadown and Toome along the way.

It came in at number 21.

Spots pipped to the post by the Causeway Coastal Route include Scotland's scenic North Coast 500, the Atlantic Highway from Bath to Falmouth, and the Isle of Arran Coast.

The Summer Road Trip Basket List states that "nothing quite prepares you for the jaw-dropping sight of Giant's Causeway, so it's worth making a day of it.

"This route, which begins in Belfast, offers plenty of potential pit stops along the way too. First, there's Carrickfergus Castle, one of the best-preserved medieval castles in Ireland.

"Then, there's The Gobbins - an adrenalin-fuelled cliff path set high above County Antrim's Islandmagee.

"There's legend-rich Ballygally and picture-perfect Cushendun to squeeze in before the finale too.

"Legend has it that an Irish giant built Giant's Causeway to fight a Scottish giant. On a clear summer's day, you might be able to spot the coast of Scotland from here, as well as seals, dolphins

and porpoises playing in the waters."

Known for its striking sea views and lookout points, the Causeway Coastal Route also joins with the Wild Atlantic Way at Muff in County Donegal and with the Mourne Coastal Route in

Belfast.

It's become particularly popular in recent years after the hit US show Game Of Thrones filmed many of its scenes across the north coast and the route can be taken by car, bicycle or foot.

Stunning coastline steeped in history

CASTLEROCK, situated five miles west of Coleraine, is an integral part of Causeway Coast and Glens borough's stunning coastline.

Very popular with summer tourists, the seaside resort's golf club has both nine and 18-hole links courses bounded by the beach, the River Bann and the Belfast to Londonderry railway line.

Local historical interest is concentrated on the 18th century Bishop of Derry's ruined palace, the Mussenden Temple on the clifftop, and the Black Glen set within the Downhill Estate, which is now owned by the National Trust.

The palace and estate were created by Frederick Hervey, 4th Earl of Bristol who was the Bishop of Derry in the 1780s.

The Mussenden Temple, with its precarious perch on the basalt cliff edge is one of the most photographed scenes in Ireland.

The 17th century Hezlett House is a thatched cottage with a cruck structure and is situated at the crossroads near the village.

Built around 1691, it was originally a rectory or farmhouse. Also at the adjacent crossroads is an ancient tree.

Castlerock was home to actor James Nesbitt as a teenager and also the holiday destination for the famous author C. S. Lewis.

Born in Belfast, he holidayed in Castlerock as a child and took inspiration from Downhill House for some of his books including *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*.

Nansy Bryson, from Castlerock, was a passenger on the ill-fated MV Princess Victoria ferry which sank on the Stranraer to Larne route in heavy seas on 31 January 1953 with the loss of 133 passengers.

A missionary, she had been at a meeting in Scotland and was returning home when the ship started to flounder.

Survivors described how she helped children into lifeboats and sang hymns before being swept into the sea herself where she drowned. She has been described as the "heroine of the Princess Victoria."

Castlerock railway station opened on July 18, 1853.

Stay safe near water and learn to swim

Advice article by Cossum Swim Schools

A RECENT American Red Cross survey shows that almost half the adults surveyed on water safety say they've had an experience where they nearly drowned, and one in four know someone who has drowned.

While over 90% of families with young children will be in the water at some point this summer, almost half (48%) plan to swim in a place with no lifeguard.

Remember when going abroad, swimming pools seldom provide lifeguard cover.

With so many planning to be in, or near the water, it is important to follow the basics of water safety, maintain constant supervision of children and to get trained!

PRACTICE WATER SAFETY

- Swim in designated areas supervised by lifeguards.
- Always swim with a buddy; do not allow anyone to swim alone.
- Ensure that everyone in the family learns to swim well. Enroll in reputable swim school that teach water orientation and Learn-to-Swim courses.
- Never leave a young child unattended near water and do not trust a child's life to another child; teach children to always ask

permission to go near water

- Have young children or inexperienced swimmers wear boating wear approved life jackets but do not rely on life jackets alone.

MAINTAIN CONSTANT SUPERVISION

- Many children who drown in home pools were out of sight for less than a few minutes and in the care of one or both parents at the time.
- Actively supervise children whenever around water - even if lifeguards are present.
- Always stay within arm's reach of young children.
- Avoid distractions when supervising children around water.

KNOW HOW TO RESPOND TO AN AQUATIC EMERGENCY

- If a child is missing, check the water first. Seconds count in preventing death or disability.
- Know how and when to call the local emergency number.
- Enroll in water safety, first aid and CPR courses to learn how to respond.
- Have appropriate equipment, such as reaching or throwing equipment, a cell phone, life jackets and a first aid kit.
- Always swim with a buddy; do not allow anyone to swim alone.
- Ensure that everyone in the family

learns to swim well. Enroll in reputable swim school that teach water orientation and Learn-to-Swim courses

- Never leave a young child unattended near water and do not trust a child's life to another child; teach children to always ask permission to go near water
- Have young children or inexperienced swimmers when boating wear approved life jackets but do not rely on life jackets alone.

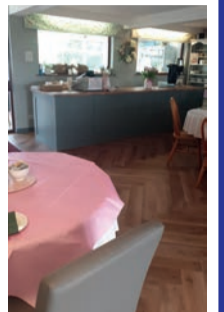
